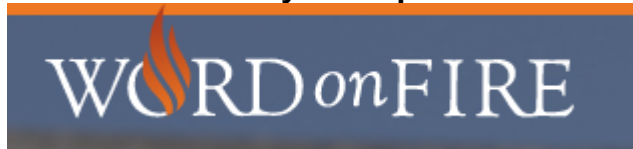

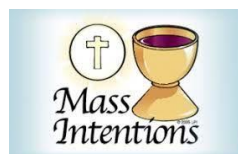

In Holy week the church celebrates the mysteries of salvation accomplished by Christ, in the last days of His earthly life from His Messianic entry into Jerusalem, to His blessed Passion and glorious Resurrection.

SATURDAY – 09 APRIL

Holy Mass 17H30 – commencing with the blessing of the palms.

PALM SUNDAY – 10 APRIL

Holy Mass Times 08H00 / 10H00 / 17H30 – commencing with the blessing of the palms

HOLY MASS during the week – 11 TO 13 APRIL

Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday @ 08h00; Monday & Wednesday @ 17h30

HOLY THURSDAY – 14 APRIL

Chrism Mass (Blessing of the oils) at the Cathedral of Christ the King ~09h30
